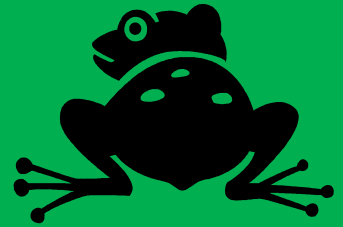




# Miss Krueger's Kindergarten Class

**Reading:** We've been busy talking about action words in books and comprehension questions!

**Writing:** Most students are just starting their books! I have conferenced with them on their second draft of their how to piece and they are shaping up quite nicely.

**Math:** The students reviewed 3D shapes on Monday. We also reviewed adding and subtracting! They also started using a trial version of Math Seeds (from the same makers of Reading Eggs)! You can access Math Seeds the same way you log into Reading Eggs, but instead click on the Math Seeds button.

**Science:** We started out last Monday with four goldfish and we have had two survivors. The kids love to observe the goldfish in the morning and when they have free time! Yesterday, we started looking at the structures on redworms. This was an interesting activity as many of them did not want to dig through the dirt or touch the worm.
