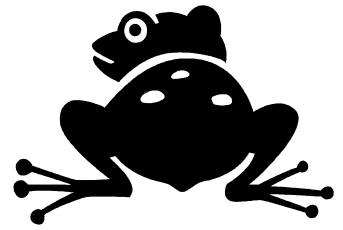




Miss Krueger's Kindergarten Class

Math: The students are excelling at this chapter on measurement. They have been doing an awesome job at describing weight, height, length, and even capacity. We reviewed and took out test today. On Monday, we will begin our unit on classifying objects.
