Reading: We continued discussing characters, setting, and sequencing this week. We reviewed how to use "First, Next, Then, and Last" when sequencing a story. We also started talking about certain consonant blends like "sh" and "ch". They enjoyed coming up with words they knew that contained these blends. We switched some guided reading groups around and I'm very impressed on how the class handled it!

Writing: The students were thrilled to get their very own sight word sheet to add to their writing folder. This is just another one of the tools they can use during Writing Workshop. I have been challenging them to use at least three of the sight words they know in their daily writing.

Math: The students have done wonderful with the addition chapter. We took a test on Wednesday and there weren't any major issues. We promptly started a new chapter on subtraction or "take away" on Thursday.
