Reading: This week, the kids got to hear the hilarious story of "The Cold Lady Who Swallowed Some Snow". We were focusing on sequencing all the items that she swallowed before she came up with a plan...to hiccup a snowman! We also focused on short vowel sounds. Many students are still getting short a and short e mixed up. We have been doing some fill in the blank CVC words to help us with that.

Writing: We reviewed how to stretch out words. Small words have only a few letters and big words have a lot of letters! I've seen great improvement with the students writing when they slow down and take their time. Often times, they rush through it and forget to write down a few sounds they hear.

Math: The students have been working on creating number sentences for subtraction problems. This isn't coming as easy for them as creating addition number sentences did. We will be reviewing with a few games the beginning of next week and taking a test on Wednesday.

Science: We officially wrapped up the wood and paper unit on Monday with our wood/paper sculptures. These were sent home on Thursday. We began exploring different kinds of fabric and brainstorming where we've seen all the samples before.

Polar Animals:

We finished up polar animals mid-week with learning about the Arctic fox and snowy owl. You may have noticed our Polar Animals information book went home on Wednesday.

Next week, we'll be digging up some fun facts about dinosaurs with a bunch of different activities!
