Reading: Our sight word of the week was "look" and our Jolly Phonics letter was "V". We kept on talking about main ideas of the big books we read throughout the week. The students also had a challenge of remembering what five animals Allie, the cat, ran into during her adventure.

Writing: The kids had some journaling time on Monday with the sub and she reviewed important writing skills like finger spaces and using uppercase letters. They got a chance to have a St. Patrick's Day writing prompt as well. When I returned, they each picked out one how to piece they liked and acted it out to find if they were missing any steps. They are going to start illustrating and neatly writing this piece into a book!

Math: The kids now have five 2D shapes that they know! We learned about the square and rectangle last week and this week we added circle, triangle, and hexagon. That last one has been pretty difficult to remember. They have been using math terms such as sides and vertices!
