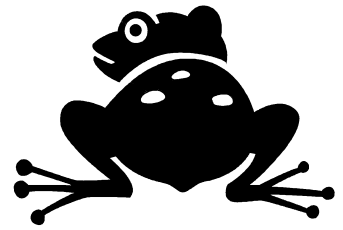




Miss Krueger's Kindergarten Class

Reading: The students continued working on their phonemic skills throughout the week. We read a new book called, "Pretend to Be a Cat". The kids liked trying to figure out what animal they were talking about with the hints!

Writing: Several students have already written three to four how-to pieces. I have encouraged students to go back and use carets to add "First, Next, Then, and Last" (transition words) to their pieces. The students learned that it can be tricky being an expert and having to explain each step!

Math: The kids took their test on classifying objects on Wednesday, but didn't follow the directions very well. ☹️ We retook the test on Thursday and I was happy to see how well they were following the directions. We then started to look at position words above/below and in front/behind. I combined some of the lessons because the students already know these words, so I'm anticipating that we will have the test soon. From there, we will be learning about 2D shapes.

Science: On Wednesday, they got to break out the droppers again. The kids got to experiment with different kinds of fabric and what happens when you put water on it.
