Reading: We read a story this week called **The Earth and I**. It was all about how the Earth and the boy were friends and how they sang and danced together! We looked at cause and effect relationships in several stories as well.

Math: We finished up our math curriculum last week, so this week we looked at money. The kids know pennies, nickels, dimes, and quarters. They did really well counting the pennies and dimes, but nickels and quarters were by far the trickiest! We continued to use Math Seeds as well.
