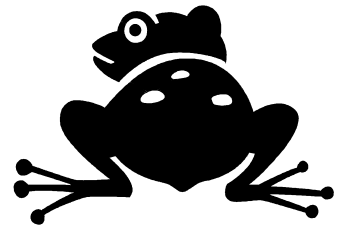




Miss Krueger's Kindergarten Class

Reading: We had a very short week! We focused on the letter Mm and our new word, “have”. We took a look at the book *The Apple Pie Tree* again. The students saw how the apple tree changed over the seasons and how it eventually became an apple pie. The students did a great job sequencing the events in the story and identifying the characters/setting. We learned the song “I’m A Little Turkey” with actions and found sight words we already knew along with rhyming words.

Writing: We were able to write in our journals on Monday. Yesterday, we had a quick check for the PALS to see how students were doing with spelling. Many students have improved greatly from just last month!

Math: We have been playing “Zap!” regularly. This game contains hard to recognize numbers such as teens and tens that the students have been having trouble identifying. They have embraced the game and it is wonderful practice for them! Since it was a short week, we will begin Chapter 4 on Monday.
