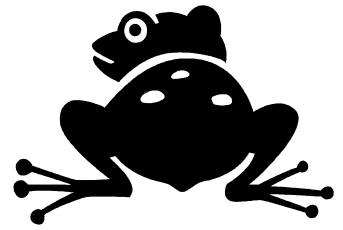




# Miss Krueger's Kindergarten Class

**Reading:** The letter of the week was Ee and the sight word was “we”. The students learned a fun little “we” song...ask them to sing it for you! Bear Snores On was our big book that helped facilitate our discussion about hibernation. We focused on characters that were in the book and predicting what would happen.

**Writing:** We started writing about true stories this week. I had them focus on things that had happened recently such as the weekend or during trick-or-treating. A lot of students have been going back to add more detail. I love to see that! Next week, we are going to work on trying to be more independent when stretching out all those hard to write words.

**Math:** We finished up our counting to fifty lesson from last Friday. We then went ahead and reviewed those tricky teen numbers. We took two or three numbers a day and used ten-frames and circles to show the teen numbers. The packet should be sent home either today or Monday.

**Science:** The class started to explore wood on Wednesday. We looked at five different samples of wood products and found out where they come from. Next week, we will be doing an experiment to see what happens when water is on wood.
