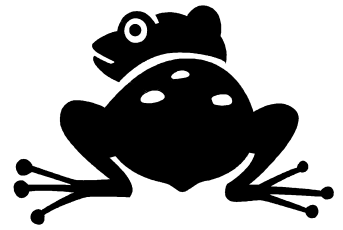




Miss Krueger's Kindergarten Class

Reading: We focused on the letter C this week and reviewed “that”. We learned a new poem “Five Little Pumpkins”. The students received their own copies of this poem to put in their book box! We highlighted ordinal number words and sight words we already learned. The students loved to find these in the text.

Writing: I encouraged students to tackle hard-to-write ideas and pictures. This means that the students have to get out of their comfort zone and write about something different. Many of your students have done this and I’m excited to see how they are adding more details to their writing!

Math: We started a new chapter this week. The main focus of these lessons was to use more than one ten-frame. They are doing a wonderful job using counters to show the teen numbers. Next week, we’ll continue to work with higher numbers and diagrams.

Pumpkins:

This week, the students received their very own pumpkins! We completed an exploration book that had us counting the lines and using snap cubes to see how tall the pumpkins were. They are still drying, so they will be sent home next week.

Science:

We wrapped up our leaf chapter by creating a leaf book with pressed leaves. Next week, we will take a look at trees over the seasons.
