Reading: We started learning about Daily 5 this week. We will eventually build up to all five rotations (Read to Self, Listen to Reading, Read with Someone, Word Work, and Writing). Throughout the week, we focused on building stamina during Read to Self. We also learned how to pick a good-fit book.

Writing: This week we focused on making our illustrations and learning how to start labeling what we've drawn. We are going to start out with the basic subject and then work our way to full sentences.

Math: The students have focused on counting the numbers 1-5 as well as writing them. You may have noticed math homework coming home. This is completely optional, but highly encouraged. Any practice the students get would be amazing!

Science: The class brainstormed some facts about trees they already knew earlier in the week. On Thursday, we walked around the school property observing trees. It was great to see the scenery and get a breath of fresh air.

Homework Golden Tickets: For every assignment a student completes, I fill out a Golden Ticket to put in a basket. I pick out a name every Friday afternoon from the basket. The student's name that I grab gets their choice of a candy bar.
