Most urgent current needs are: laundry detergent (high efficiency for front-loading machines); large heavyweight garbage bags; anti-bacterial dish soap; liquid and powder bleach; and clay cat litter (non-scoopable).

Welcome donations include: canned dog, cat and kitten food; gift cards for gas or local stores; medium or large dog crates (metal or plastic) to be used as cat cages; rawhides and dog chews; durable dog toys; paper towels; dryer sheets; general cleaning supplies; copy paper; pens; 951 color and 950 black inkjet cartridges; Vitamin C (keeps the animals healthy!); lysine; and meat-based baby food.
