You will find a monthly calendar in your child's folder as well. This calendar is to show what color he/she ended up on during the day. I split the day into two parts, so your child will mark what color they were on before lunch and at the end of the day. If they can make it through the month with less than 4 yellows, they will be able to eat lunch in the classroom with me!

The kindergarten classes will be learning about apples and apple orchards in the upcoming weeks. We are going to travel to Poynette to visit Lapacek's Apple Orchard.
